Award for best paper on Surgical Site Infection related to wound management and closure

The Surgical Infection Society of Europe are pleased to announce the launch of an event to find the best paper on 'Surgical Site Infection related to wound management and closure'. The submission will consist of an original investigation paper on SSI related to wound management and closure, accepted or published in a JCR indexed journal in 2009-2010.

The winner will receive funding of €10,000 (for investment in a self defined educational or scientific project, agreed with the SIS-E in advance) and three years membership of the SIS-E. The winner will be announced at the SIS-E 2011 congress in Leon (Spain).

This award is open to all HCP's, worldwide.

Funding for this award has been provided by ETHICON, a JOHNSON & JOHNSON company via an unrestricted educational grant. The selection and adjudication of the winner of this award will be by the SIS-E President, past president, Vice president, secretary and councillors of the Surgical Infection Society Europe and is independent of ETHICON.
