

## **Infection Prevention Society (IPS) Institutional Membership**

### **What is Institutional Membership**

Institutional Membership is a group membership and is aimed at organisations with employees in healthcare-related roles, thereby broadening its multi-disciplinary constitution. Institutional membership provides healthcare and educational organisations with access to resources, networks and educational opportunities provided by the IPS.

### **Eligibility**

Eligible organisations include:

- a. Healthcare organisations (e.g. NHS, private sector)
- b. Educational institutions (e.g. Higher Education)
- c. Professional societies related to healthcare

### **What are the benefits to having Institutional Membership**

21- 30 members	£1800.00
31- 50 members	£3000.00
