What is Institutional Membership

Institutional Membership is a group membership and is aimed at organisations with employees in healthcare-related roles, thereby broadening its multi-disciplinary constitution. Institutional membership provides healthcare and educational organisations with access to resources, networks and educational opportunities provided by the IPS.

Eligibility

Eligible organisations include:

- a. Healthcare organisations (e.g. NHS, private sector)
- b. Educational institutions (e.g. Higher Education)
- c. Professional societies related to healthcare
